

## Reciprocity-Transfer of Certification from another State

---

The North Carolina Fire and Rescue Commission grants equivalent certification to any program that is accredited by the International Fire Service Accreditation Congress (IFSAC) or the National Board on Fire Service Professional Qualifications (Pro Board). The Fire and Rescue Commission can not give credit for classes. Reciprocity will only be given for completed certifications. If you are not sure your state is accredited you may go to [www.ifsac.org](http://www.ifsac.org) and [www.theproboard.org](http://www.theproboard.org) , click on accredited agencies/entities to view a listing of accredited states.

To apply for reciprocity you must complete an application for certification and mail copies of your original certificates with the accreditation statement to:
